★ Start or join a club: ★

- Local libraries have many fun and beginner friendly craft and book clubs that anyone can join at any age. Go to their websites for info, who knows what you'll find.
- Online groups organize in person meet ups for all kinds of niches. Photography, Dnd, poetry, you name it.

★ Show up to something: ★

- Concerts are happening everywhere around you, you just have to know where to look. Never to be afraid to reach out to random bands to ask about their shows. Trust me they would love to have you there.

If you're tight for cash reach out anyway. Often times bands can still find a way to get you in. This only applies to local bands, remember community starts around you first.

- Flea markets and art/zine fests pop up all the time. Find organizers and stay informed. Utilize the internet and find a way to get involved. We have it for a reason.

Have some money?

Fund local & small and actually
talk to artists!

Everyone has something to
share, get out there and say it.

CONSUME -> TRANSFORM

Non-stop creating will only drive you into a wall. Stop when you need to refill the creative well. Allow yourself to pause and absorb new or familiar art that you feel moved by.



Use your passion to create and pour those new ideas back into the things you make.

Draw that fanart. Study your niche interests. Write essays. Put on a play. Enjoy. Make. Transform.



Art block will always be a part of the creating process. Don't let getting stuck derail your entire project. You just need to take a breath and find a new medium that engages your brain in a different way.

Having trouble writing? Explore an artform that requires visuals. Go to a museum to look for photography exhibits.

Having trouble drawing? Find an audiobook version of a book you've been putting off reading.

Your phone can be a tool but don't let it be the end all, be all.
